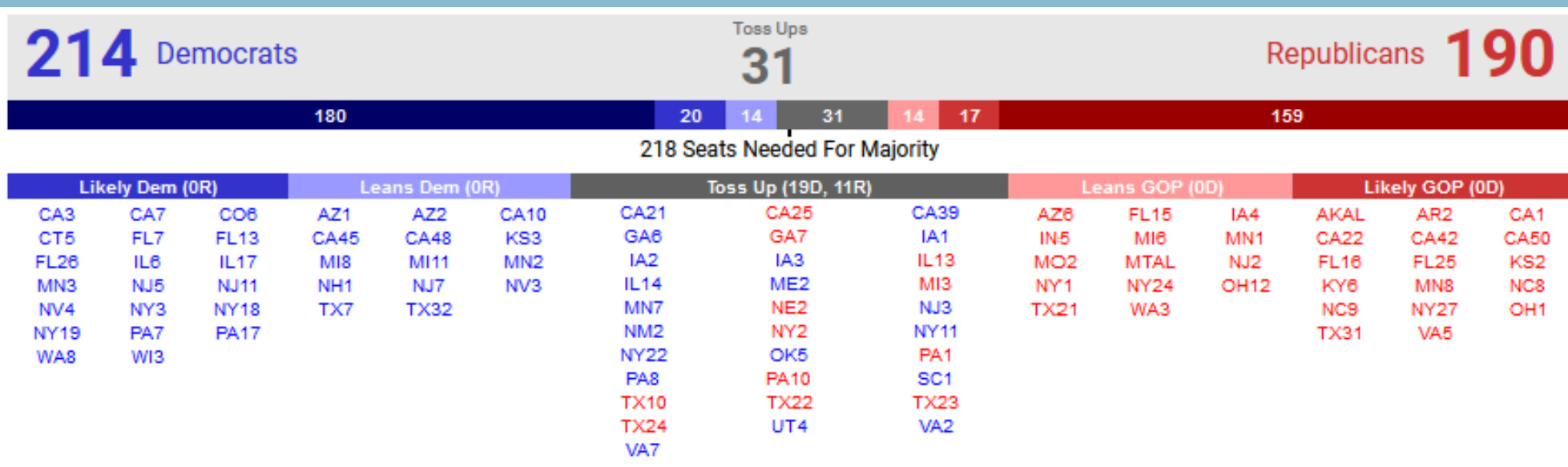

US Senate

- To gain control of the Senate the Democrats need to net:
 - Three seats if Biden wins
 - Four seats if Trump wins
- The Math: Democrats will likely lose Alabama, meaning they net to gain four to five seats
 - Most likely: Arizona, Colorado, Maine, and North Carolina

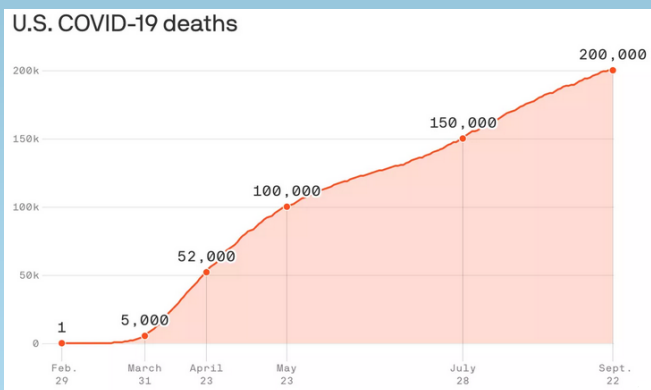

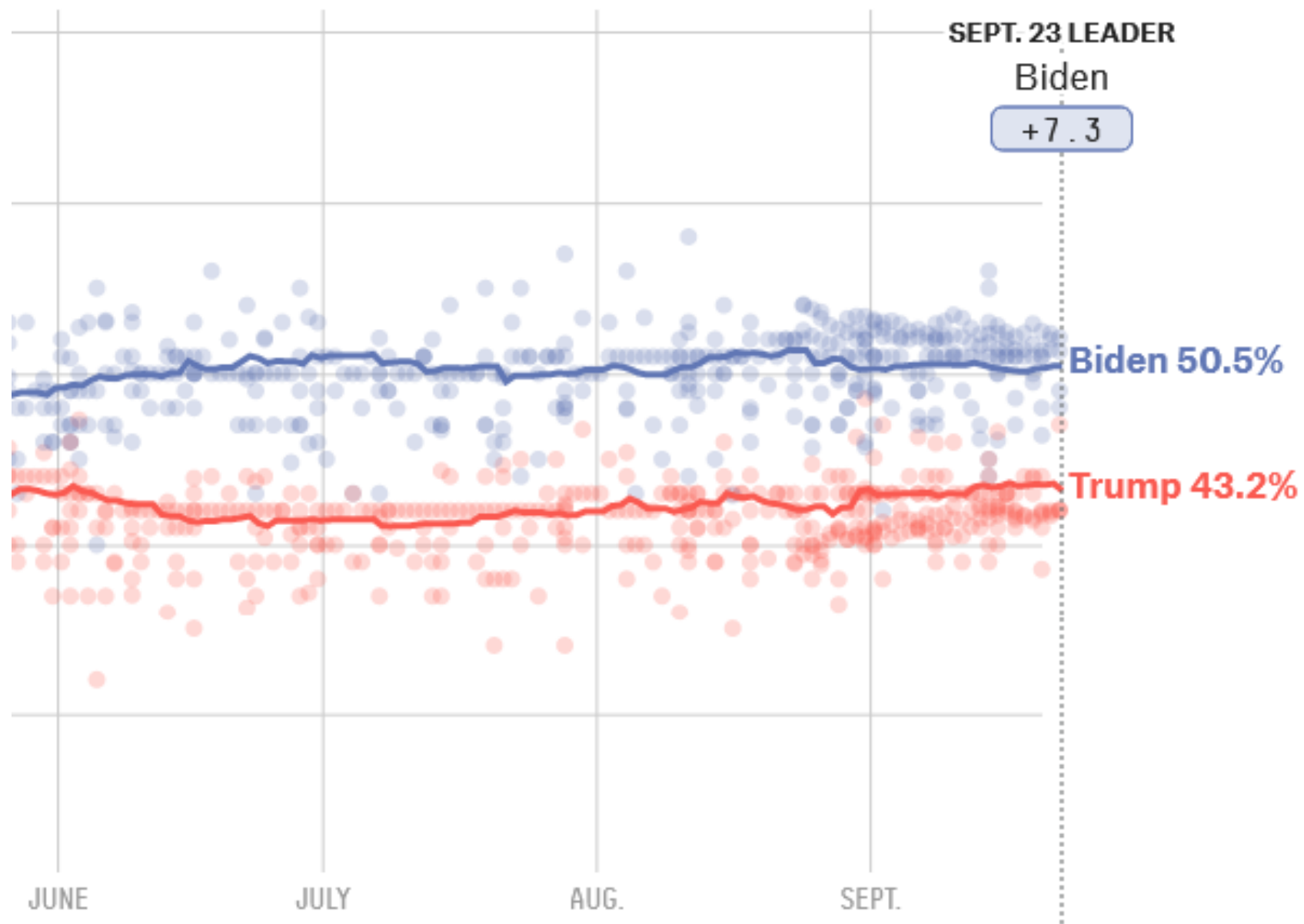

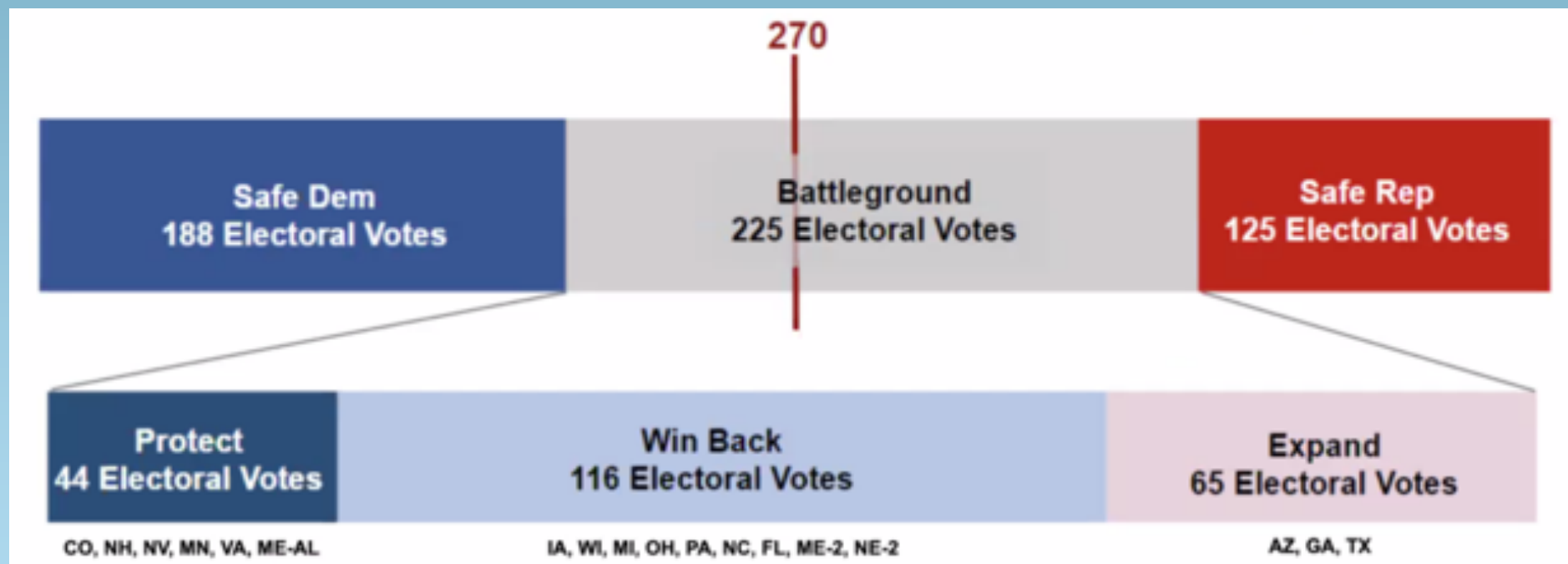


Vice President Biden well positioned going into the fall

- VP Biden has held a lead over Trump since joining the race
Currently leads by 7 points
 - Roughly the same as in March
- VP Biden's favorables are rising, currently around 51%
 - Trump stagnates around **43%**
- More voters trust VP Biden (47%) than Trump (39%) with public safety
 - Including among suburbanites and Independents

The electoral map favors Vice President Biden

VP Biden starts with **188 electoral votes from solidly Democratic states**. To reach 270, he needs to win an **additional 82 electoral votes** from the battleground states.



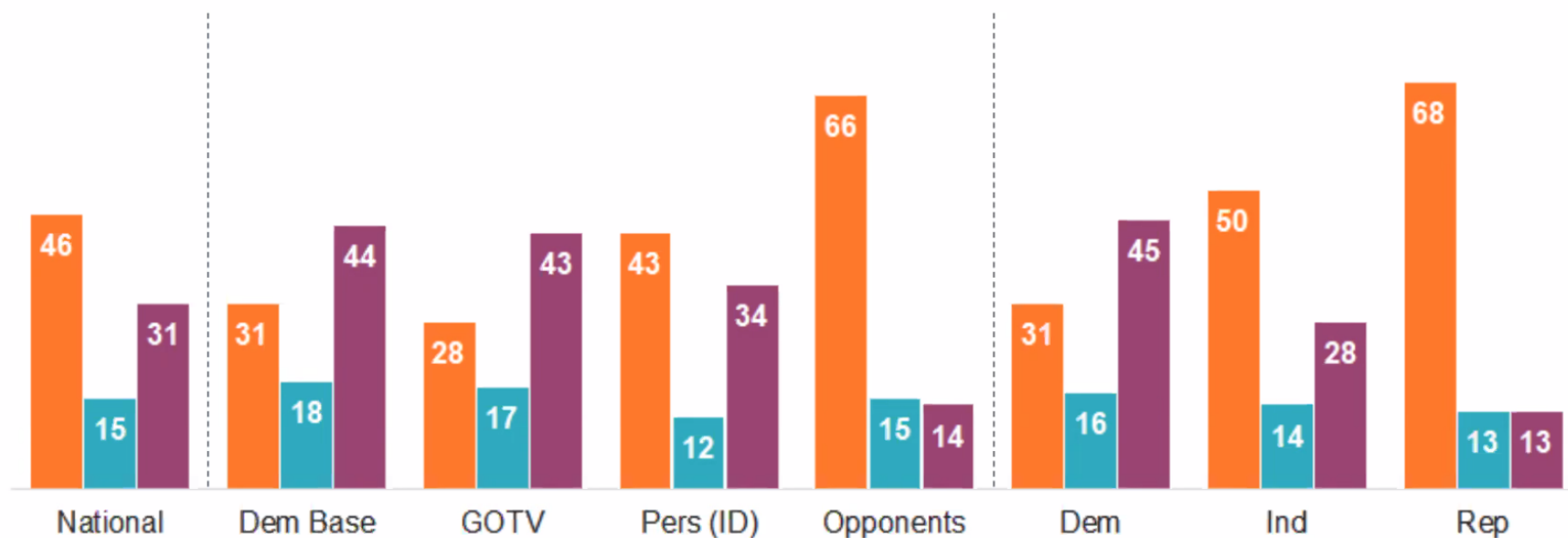
The 17 battleground states and districts comprise of 225 electoral votes.

Democratic Members More Likely to Vote by Mail, Others More Likely to Opt for In-Person Voting on Election Day

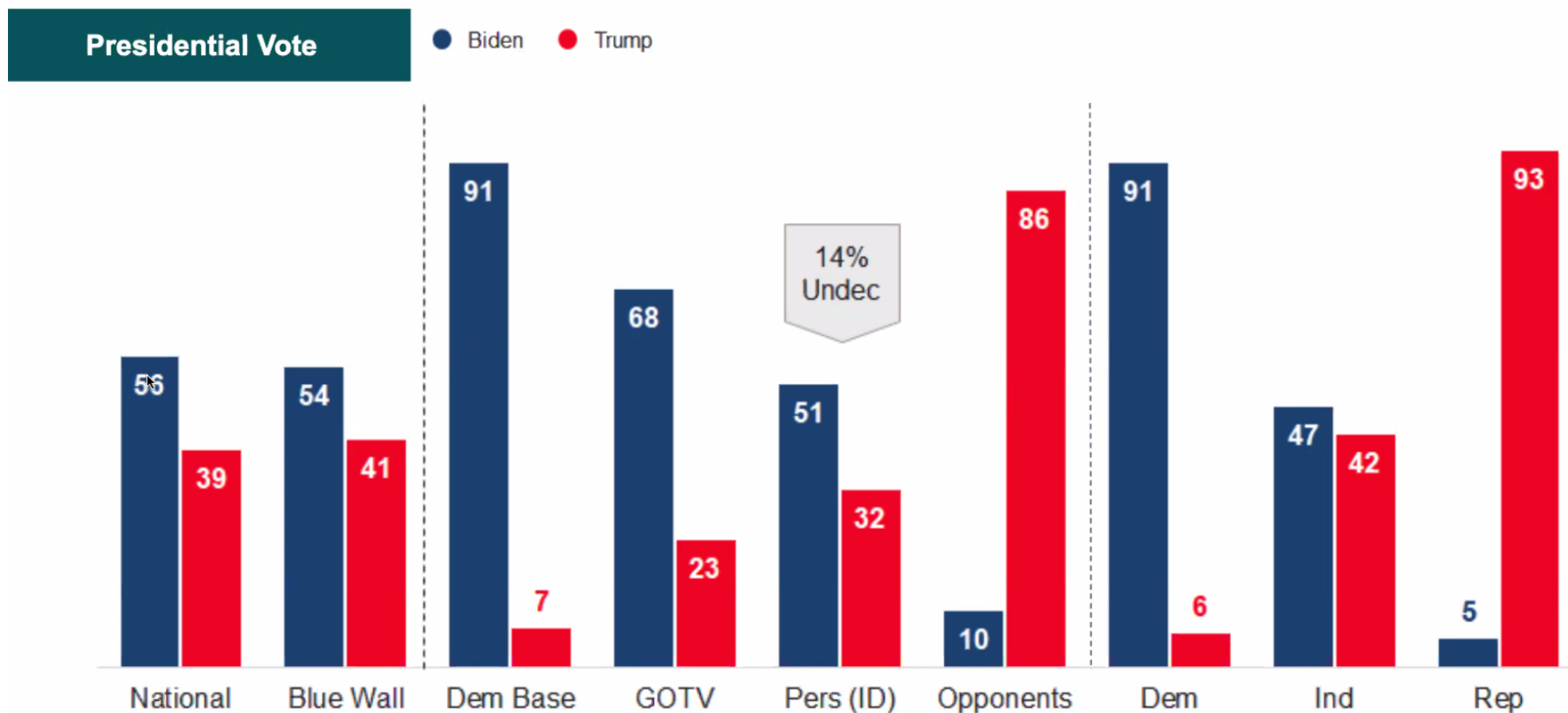

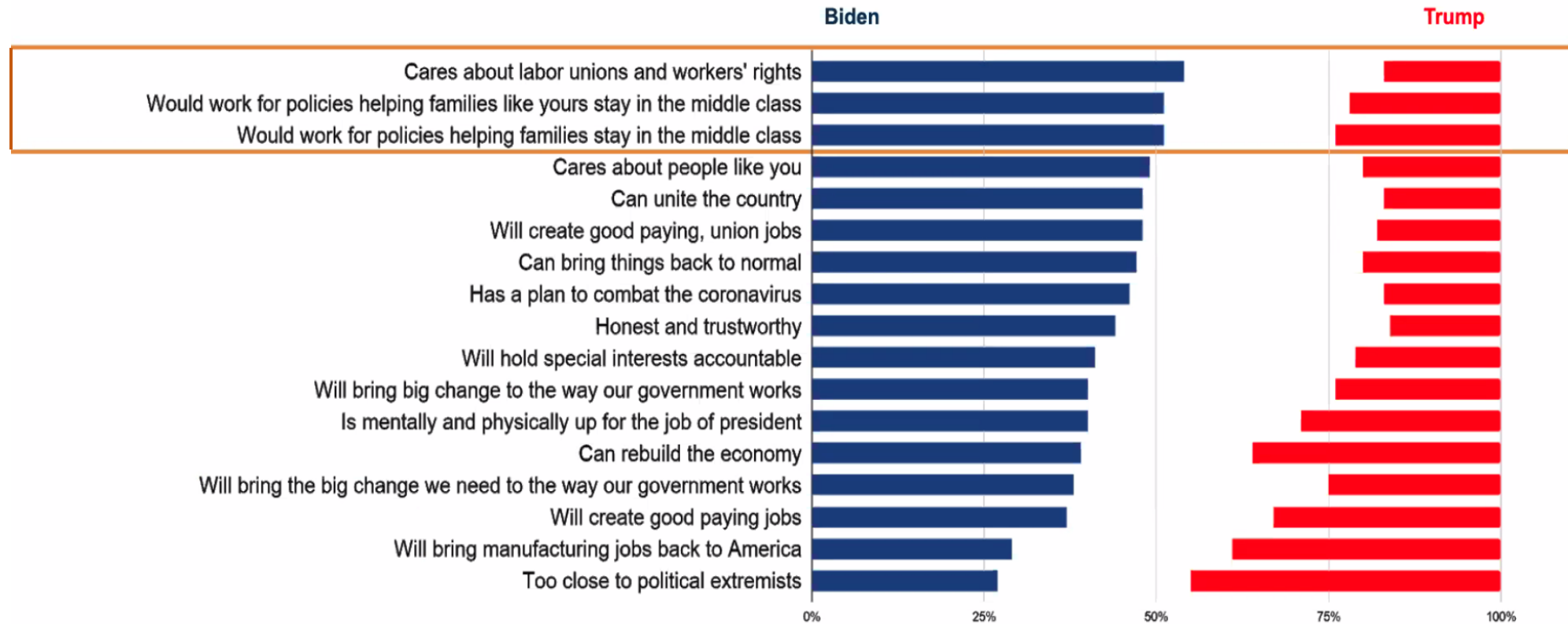
Biden Holds a Double-Digit Lead with Members Overall, Slim Lead With Independents and Conflicted Members



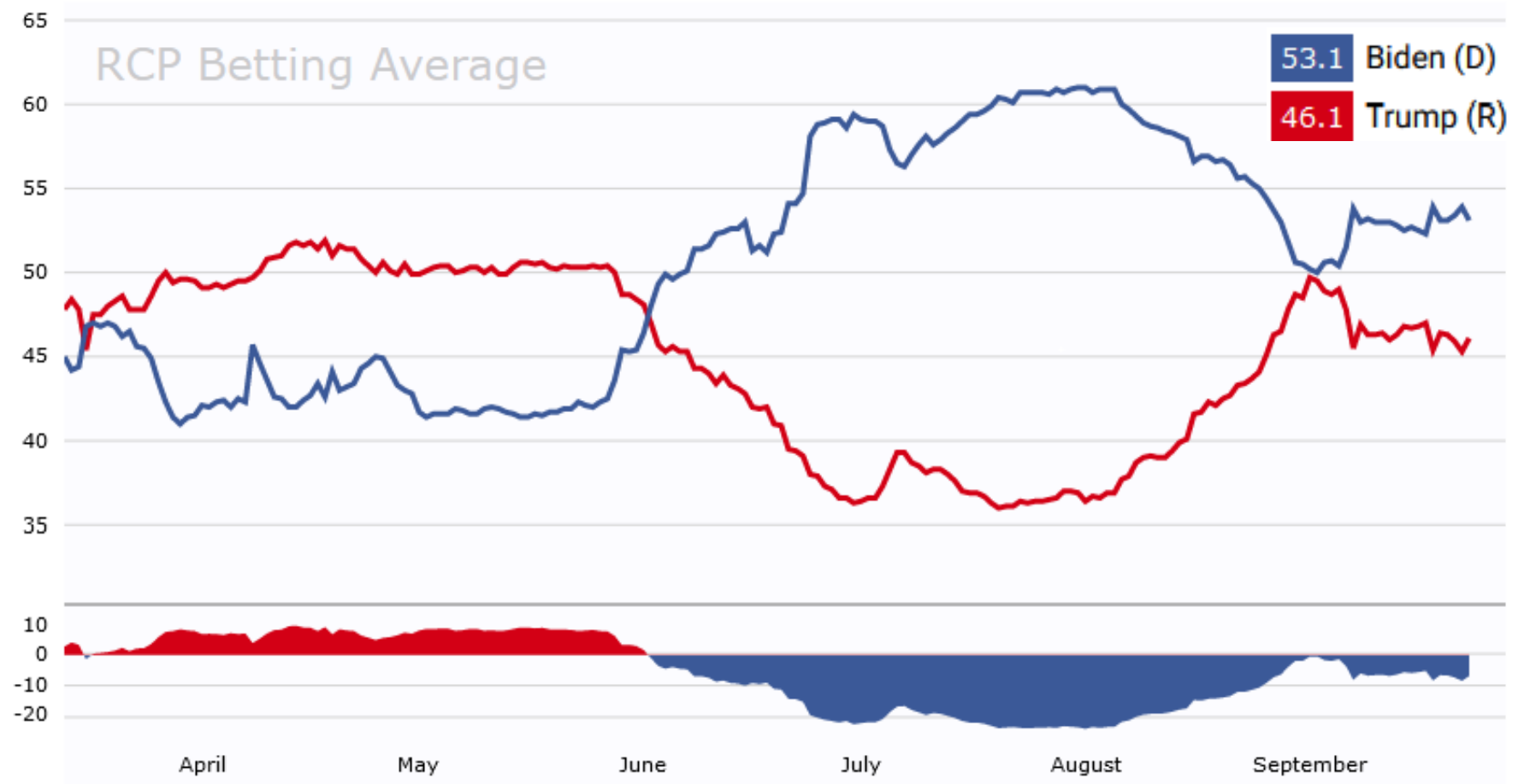
Biden Best Described as For Unions & the Middle Class Among Turnout and Conflicted Audiences

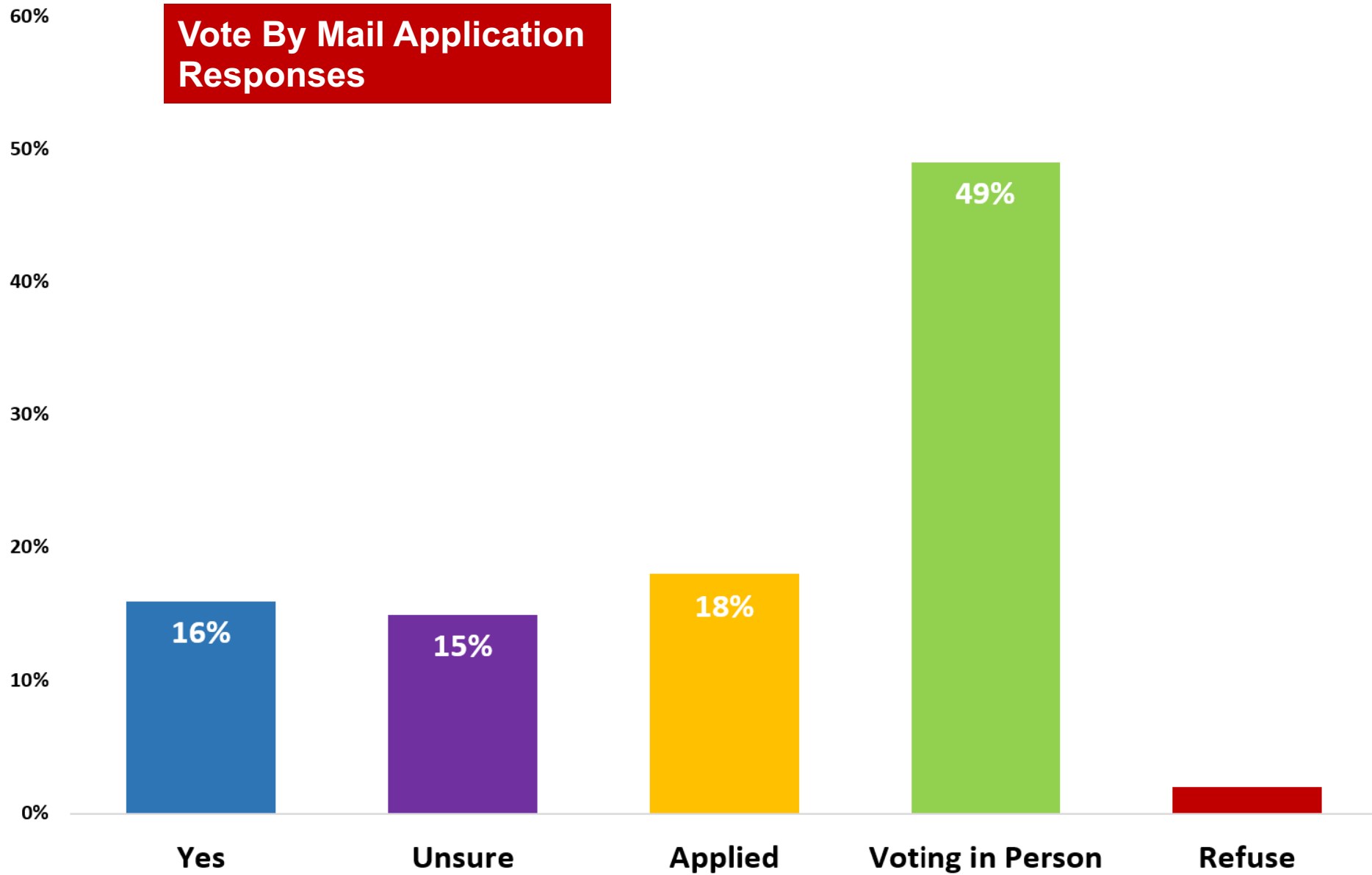
